

# MIDDLESEX SMALL BORE RIFLE ASSOCIATION

## 2019 SHORT RANGE PRONE RIFLE SUMMER LEAGUE

The Competition is open to Affiliated Clubs and invited teams of FOUR, shot on N.S.R.A 1989 series targets at 15, 20 or 25 yds. over TEN rounds at fortnightly intervals. Shooting will be conducted under N.S.R.A. Rules for postal shooting, and subject to M.S.B.R.A. Local Rules where applicable. CARDS MAY BE SHOT ON RECEIPT OF LABELS.

Teams will be placed in divisions of SIX according to their Short Range Averages. These should be calculated to one decimal place from Rounds 1 to 7 of the previous seasons M.S.B.R.A. League. (If 7 rounds have not been shot, or the individual has not previously shot in the M.S.B.R.A. League, the scores should be made up from the most recently confirmed short range from scores on accredited targets).

**PLEASE NOTE THAT THE ORGANISERS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO ADJUST ANY SUBMITTED AVERAGE.**

RESERVES MAY HAVE AN AVERAGE HIGHER THAN THE SHOOTER THEY REPLACE SUBJECT TO NSRA RULE 7.9.7

Members of the winning team in each division will receive a Middlesex Medal, and each winning team shall be eligible to shoot in the League Final. The team member scoring the Highest Individual Aggregate OVER TEN ROUNDS will be eligible to shoot in the Individual Final. These Finals will be scored using the Macrae Handicap system, the average for which will be that attained in the League.

A tie for the Highest Individual Average will be decided by countback. The team winning the Finals shoot will be awarded the EMI Cup, which will be presented at the County Prizegiving. The shooter returning the Highest Individual Aggregate over 10 rounds will be awarded a Middlesex Silver type Medal.

(Teams and Individuals not attending the Prizegiving will be responsible for collection of their awards by arrangement with the Awards Officer).

PLEASE NOTE THAT THERE IS NO MATCH PERIOD - CARDS MAY BE SHOT AT ANY TIME AFTER RECEIPT OF LABELS.

ENTRY FEE - £10 per team.

The fee includes entry to The Rule Cup Competition for Affiliated Clubs.
